
## Hi Steve,

Here's the schematic for the Ck switching input jacks. I've never tried this circuit but it looks like it should work. The jacks are 4 tab mono. They are the usual type used in English amps with a non isolated switch on both the ground and hot contacts. Input resistance will be 1M or greater for both inputs so the Lo gain input won't be a tone sucker.



If you plug into input 1 the switch on input 2 sleeve contact connects the 25u across the 1k5 for max gain. Plugging into input 2 disconnects the 25u. The 25u could be replaced with 0.68u or your favourite value for a different tone for the high gain input. Another tone option would be to keep the 25u and have the 0.68u permanently across the 1k5. Input 1 would then have 25u Ck and input 2 0.68u Ck. If like me you like to have that option on your amps it would save having to drill a hole for a mini toggle switch.
